## Calculating Continuing Professional Education Hours

One continuing professional education hour is earned for each fifty minutes of active participation (excluding lunches and breaks) in a professional educational activity.
Continuing professional education hours are only earned in full-hour increments and rounding must be down. For example, a QSA who attends an eight-hour presentation ( 480 minutes) with 90 minutes of breaks will earn seven (7) continuing professional education hours.

Sample Calculation
Educational Activity Schedule Actual Hours Minutes
9:00 am - 5:00 pm $8.0 \quad 480$
Less: Two 15-minute breaks 0.50
Less: Lunch - 1 hour 1.060
$\begin{array}{lll}\text { Total hours of educational activity } & 6.5 & 390\end{array}$

## Calculation of CE Hours

390 minutes divided by 50 minutes $=7.8$ or 7 CE hours (rounded down)
